3 Stages of the Pool Season

1st Stage – Early Spring to Summer

Temperature fluctuations & a lot of rain will cause the Alkalinity and pH to be out of balance regularly. Green water becomes common, along with staining. Be vigilant with testing and balancing.

2nd Stage – Middle of Summer

Weather stabilizes but pool owners tend to let their guard down and become complacent. Continue to practice positive pool habits. **Remember-** Pool chemistry requires regular maintenance regardless of pool clarity

3rd Stage – End of Summer & Early Fall

Intense heat, larger bather loads and longer days of sunshine forces shocking/superchlorinating/boosting at the rates of every 3-4 days. Algae can become resistant to normal chlorine levels and may need to be treated with algaecide. If your pool turns green, a shock treatment of 5 times the normal amount may be necessary to completely oxidize the outbreak.

Your pool is supposed to be fun and enjoyable. Do not stress on maintenance. Call us with any questions you may have or bring in a water sample (12oz. of fresh pool water taken away from a return jet) for a free water analysis.
